

Walnut Hill Volunteers In Patrol Minutes April 29, 2009

The meeting was called to order by Chair Bob Noyes at 7:05PM

Officer Spivey gave a detailed report of crime activity in our neighborhood, with handouts, There was a significant reduction in residential burglary and a slight increase in thefts and burglary of a motor vehicle (BMV), resulting in an overall 12% reduction in crime. There were 3 BMV's and an auto theft of a Cadillac. Officer Jaquez reported that the police, at our request, would come to our meeting location some evening to etch vehicle numbers (VIN) on auto windows AND/OR etch property numbers on valuables.

Bill Marx reported on mail box theft in one area.

Ross Coulter reported that our Enhanced Neighborhood Patrol, ENP, activity. Linda Befort's treasury handout lists 321 households, 31%, paid to this activity.

Paul Figel reported that the police responded rapidly to a 911 call about teenagers loitering in his back alley.

Art Befort reported that, while on patrol, he and Linda interacted with our police patrol and had a man picked up for suspicious activity in our northwest quadrant.

Linda Befort's treasury handout reports over \$5800.00 balance with more money arriving as a result of the recent Homeowners meeting (council candidates debate).
