Paid Police Patrol Update



Since beginning in late March, we have raised more than \$22,000 for the paid police patrol, which puts us more than halfway to our goal of \$40,000. We had an initial rush in donations, but would like to finish our fundraising for the first year of patrol as soon as possible, so we need as many people as possible to contribute.

\$40,000 would get us close to 4 hours per day of patrol by an armed, off-duty Dallas policeman in uniform and in a police car. The impact of this patrol would be extraordinary, as evidenced by the Sparkman neighborhood to our west, where in the first year of their patrol they saw nearly a 50% drop in crime.

Homes contributing to the patrol will have access to the cell phone carried by the patrolling officers, enabling you to have a policeman (when they are working our neighborhood) at your house in only a few minutes should you have a problem. Also, when you go out of town on vacation, paying homes can let the officers know and they will make a stop by your property to check things out for you. Finally, we will have special email updates about the patrol hours and activity in our neighborhood.

We will soon have some folks going door-to-door collecting for the patrol, and if you have not done so yet we really ask you to consider paying into the patrol. More contributors mean more hours of dedicated officers patrolling our neighborhood, and the less we have to worry about criminals targeting our homes.
