Meeting Minutes

The WHHA VIP April 2024 meeting convened at 6:34 pm at the Walnut Hill Recreation Center. Geoge Leporis, WHHA resident, attended our VIP meeting, and is considering joining as a VIP member.

Dallas Police Department:

Officer Kim and Officer Brookins provided updates:

- Crime data can be found at Dallaspolice.net:
 - o https://www.dallaspolice.net/resources/CrimeReports/NIBRS%20Weekly%20Beat%20Report.pdf
- Statistics for WHHA continue a positive (NEGATIVE) trend for 2024:
 - ZERO violent crime
 - 1 Burglary-Business was a vacant house under renovation. Such structures are considered a 'business' until occupied.
 - BMV (Burglary Moter Vehicle) has increased slightly.
 - UNLOCKED vehicles present the best/easy targets for crimes-of-opportunity.
 Most BMVs occur between 12 midnight 6 am.
 - We are advised to LOCK our vehicles (driveway, street, everywhere)
 - Theft & robberies at El Rancho have declined this year
 - Our area continues to run LOW on all crime.
 - Officers noted:
 - The presence of ENP in a neighborhood deters crime (criminals/homeless often scope areas for LACK of surveillance to act out property/personal violations)
 - Cameras are an excellent tool in crime-prevention/reporting. 1080p is the recommended resolution. Most cameras today meet this standard.

Questions:

- Q: What can be done about speeding (high-school-related) and young people lurking in the alleys in WHHA?
 - A:
- Decoy cars are no longer available to our DPD officers to help reduce speeding.
- WHHA residents can call NW Division for assistance with both issues.
- Speeding reports will be forwarded to the Traffic Unit (but they generally deploy to the larger streets).
- Tickets have been/are issued when experienced first-hand by officers
- Speed-bumps have been investigated, but due to cost and lack of adequate community support, the proposal has died.
- Q: What can be done about people ordering food-delivery to locations in the WHHA
 neighborhood (NOT ordered by WHHA residents)? (Residents decline the orders if the
 delivery service knocks at the residents' doors.)
 - A: This odd problem can't really be deterred. By declining delivery, this MAY alert the food/delivery service to decline accepting the orders in the first place.

Dallas Fire and Rescue:

Dallas Fire & Rescue Fire Captain Serrano joined the meeting, proving an entertaining report on our local Station 35:

- An AMBULANCE may join Station 35 as early as August 2024
- Station 35 (and all firestations) are staffed by EMTs, and are versed in solving a wide variety of problems, not limited to fire & rescue!
 - o All firefighters are trained in Active-Shooter situations
 - o Help with fire/smoke alarms & detectors
 - Rescue cats-in-trees
 - Cooking oil recycling center on-site
 - Safe Place (baby-safe-place)
 - Car-seat installation
 - o Etc.
- Captain Serrano is one of three captains, covering 3 shifts at the station.
 - Visit ANYTIME (but best hours are 8-5)
 - o He'll do his best to attend (with a truck or engine) our community events
 - o Did You Know...Firefighters must maintain their own station and themselves:
 - Clean facilities (inside and out)
 - Clean trucks & engines
 - Maintain lawn and grounds
 - Shop for and provide their own food
 - Prepare and cook their own meals

• Questions:

- Q: Is it true that WHHA is on the same "electrical grid" as the Firestation? We seem to have had FAR FEWER electrical outages than in the past...
 - A: Just a rumor!! In fact, Station 35 (and all firestations) have their own generators. In a power-outage, we are welcome to come by to charge our phones, or seek other assistance.
